Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>The academic year 2019-20 was extended until the month of October 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and the academic year 2020-21 began in November 2020. Due to the Covid-19 second wave and anticipated third wave, the academic year 2020-21 has been disturbed and delayed. The teaching and learning process is hampered by the institution's recurrent partial closure. The pandemic teaching and learning concerns are addressed and online classes and face-to-face physical classes are conducted in order to reduce learning losses as much as possible. All proper steps and actions are taken to ensure that the courses' syllabus is finished on time, utilizing Information and communications technology (ICT) tools for remote or online teaching providing a variety of options. The abrupt transition from traditional to online education was problematic for some non-technical teachers. Members of the faculty received online training and attended online Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs) to prepare themselves for the crisis, and they continued to work from home 24/7 inculcating the spirit of facing the challenges in the minds of students and alleviating the fears and distress of the crisis. The lecturers held extra special classes on Zoom, often late in the evening, to finish the syllabus and even conduct online doubt-clearing sessions. Slow learners were given extra attention, and advanced students were encouraged to use internet resources to expand their knowledge and skills. Syllabi, unit-specific video source links, question banks, study material, and other student-supporting information are developed and made available through the Webpros, college management information system.</p>
